NOTIFICATION

The 12th March, 2024

No. MER. 439389/39.- In supersession of the Admission Rules for the Post Doctoral (Doctorate of Medicine and Master of Chirurgiae) Degree Courses in the Medical Colleges of the State of Assam, 2008, as notified vide No.HLB.161/2008/2, dated 17th June, 2008 the Governor of Assam is hereby pleased to make the following rules to regulate the admission of students in the Doctorate of Medicine (D.M.) and Master of Chirurgiae (M.Ch) Courses in the Medical Colleges in the manner hereinafter appearing, namely:-

- Short title and commencement
1. (1) These rules may be called the Medical Colleges of Assam, (Regulation of Admission into 1st year Doctorate of Medicine (D.M.) /Master of Chirurgiae (M.Ch) Courses) Rules, 2024.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette and shall be applicable from the academic session 2024 to regulate the admission of students into the Doctorate of Medicine (D.M.)/ Master of Chirurgiae (M.Ch) courses in the Medical Colleges of Assam.
- Definitions
2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires. —
- (i) "College" means Medical Colleges of Assam where Doctorate of Medicine (D.M.) and Master of Chirurgiae (M.Ch) courses are available or may be started in future;
- (ii) "DGHS" means the Director General of Health Services, Government of India;

- (iii) "DME" means Director of Medical Education, Assam;
- (iv) "Examination" means NEET-SS;
- (v) "Examination Conducting Authority" means National Board of Examinations or any Authority as may be decided by the Government of India from time to time to conduct the NEET-SS;
- (vi) "Government" means the Government of Assam;
- (vii) "GOI" means the Government of India;
- (viii) "MCC" means Medical Counselling Committee;
- (ix) "NMC" means National Medical Commission, New Delhi;
- (x) "NBE" means National Board of Examination;
- (xi) "NEET-SS" means National Eligibility cum Entrance Test for admission into Super Speciality courses (Doctorate of Medicine or Master of Chirurgiae);
- (xii) "University" means the Srimanta Sankaradeva University of Health Sciences, Guwahati.
- Eligibility criteria for appearing NEET-SS 3. For appearing NEET-SS, the candidate shall fulfill the eligibility criteria as prescribed in the Information Bulletin for National Eligibility - cum - Entrance Test (Super Specialty Courses) published by the Examination Conducting Authority before starting the process of NEET-SS of the particular session.
- Procedures of the Examination 4. All the procedures of the examination shall be as per the steps laid down in the Information Bulletin for National Eligibility - cum - Entrance Test (Super Specialty Courses) published by the Examination Conducting Authority before starting the process of NEET-SS of the particular session.
- Result and counselling for allotment of seats 5. The declaration of result followed by counselling for allotment of seats etc. shall be done as per the procedures as mentioned in the Information Bulletin for National Eligibility - cum - Entrance Test (Super Specialty Courses) published by the Examination Conducting Authority before starting the process of NEET-SS of the particular session
- Number of seats 6. The number of seats shall be available in the office website of the Directorate of Medical Education Assam and shall be updated from time to time.
- Reservation of Seats 7. There shall be no reservation of seats for Super Specialty Doctorate of Medicine (DM) and Master of Chirurgiae (M.Ch) courses and the guidelines as mentioned in the information Bulletin for NEET SS published by Examination Conducting Authority shall be followed.

- Admission
8. (1) Students who are allotted seats in the Medical Colleges of Assam shall report physically to the concerned college authority within the stipulated time for admission as instructed by the National Medical Commission. They shall follow all the procedures as declared in the website of Director General of Health Services or National Board of Examination or Medical Counselling Committee or Examination Conducting Authority.
- (2) The students shall submit the following documents in original to the college authority at the time of admission:-
- (a) Admit Card issued by NEET-SS/Examination Conducting Authority;
 - (b) Rank Letter issued by NBE/Examination Conducting Authority;
 - (c) Allotment letter;
 - (d) Doctor of Medicine (M.D) or Master in Surgery (M.S) or Diplomate of National Board (DNB) Post Graduate (P.G) Degree Pass Certificate issued by competent authority and Mark Sheets obtained in the concerned Specialty;
 - (e) Registration Certificate of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) or M.D/M.S or DNB issued by MCI or NMC or State Medical Council. (Students who have completed Post Graduation by 31st July, of the particular session are eligible to apply with provisional certificate of PG Degree);
 - (f) High School Admit Card or Pass Certificate or proof of date of birth;
 - (g) Mark sheets and Pass certificate of HSSLC (10+2);
 - (h) Mark Sheets of all MBBS Examinations;
 - (i) Pass Certificate of MBBS Examinations;
 - (j) Internship completion certificate;
 - (k) Proof of permanent address: Driving Licence or Adhaar Card or Passport (Photocopy of any one);
 - (l) Deed of Agreement duly filled-up and signed by the candidate (in original) in a non judicial stamp paper of appropriate value.

All the academic testimonials in original shall remain in custody of the college authority until the completion of the course.

- (3) All candidates who are admitted in D.M. and M.Ch Course in the Medical Colleges of Assam shall Registrar their names in Assam Council of Medical Registration within 3(three) months of Admission.
- Admission fees 9. The Admission fees details for D.M. and M.Ch courses shall be uploaded in the college website before starting the process of admission. The same shall also be available in the website of Medical Counselling Committee (MCC).
- Refund of fees 10. (1) A candidate who wants to leave the College for upgradation of the seat during the stipulated time for that particular counseling session shall get a refund of 90% of the fees already deposited at the time of admission.
- (2) A candidate who surrenders the seat before the last date of admission shall also be eligible for refund of 90% of the fees already deposited at the time of admission.
- (3) No refund shall be allowed after the last date of admission.
- Stipend 11. (1) The students admitted into the D.M/ M.Ch. course shall be eligible for stipend as per the existing norms of Government of Assam.
- (2) Candidates who are in regular service under the Government of Assam and if otherwise eligible for study leave shall draw their regular salary as notified by Government of Assam. The candidates who are on study leave with Extra Ordinary Leave may opt to take stipend during the period of the course.
- Surrender of Seat after last date of admission 12. (1) The candidate who surrenders the seat after the last date of surrender before the last scheduled counselling date shall pay a penalty of Rs.20,00,000/- (Rupees twenty lakhs) only by way of Bank Draft in favour of Director of Medical Education, Assam, payable at Guwahati.
- (2) The candidate shall also deposit the amount of stipend already drawn during the course of study by way of Bank Draft in favour of Director of Medical Education Assam, Guwahati payable at Guwahati.
- Mandatory Service 13. (1) All candidates except those in regular service under the Government of Assam selected for admission into D.M or M.Ch Course in the Medical Colleges of Assam shall have to compulsorily serve under the Government of Assam or eligible agency notified by the Department for a mandatory period of 1(one) year following the successful completion of his or her D.M/M.Ch course or pay

- compensation of Rs.30.00 (Rupees thirty) lakhs only to the Government.
- (2) The candidates who are in regular service under the Government of Assam and admitted in D.M/M.Ch course shall have to serve the Government of Assam for a minimum period of 15 years after successful completion of the course or pay Rs.1.00 (rupees One) Crore as compensation.
- Transfer 14. No transfer shall be allowed from one Medical College to another Medical College under any circumstances after last date of admission for a session.
- Agreement 15. All candidates selected for admission into D.M/M.Ch Courses in the Medical Colleges of Assam shall enter into an Agreement in a non judicial stamp paper of appropriate value with the Government of Assam as in Schedule - I, appended to these rules for binding himself or herself to serve under the Government of Assam as per rule 11.
- Issue of Original Pass Certificate by the University 16. A candidate shall be eligible for obtaining the provisional pass certificate from the College authority after successful completion of the course. The original pass certificate shall be issued by the University only after complete fulfillment of the terms and conditions of the Agreement.
- Anti Ragging Measures 17. The Medical Council of India shall follow the provisions of the National Medical Commission (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Medical College or Colleges or Institutions) Regulations, 2009 for prevention of the occurrence of any ragging, regulating and punishing those who indulge in ragging. The Medical Council of India has made it mandatory for all students or parents to submit anti-ragging related Undertaking to the Institutions at the time of admission (details shall be downloaded from the website of NMC).
- Interpretation of any clause of these rules 18. In case of any doubt regarding interpretation of any clause of these rules, the decision of the DME, Assam or Medical Education and Research Department, Government of Assam shall be final.
- Power to relax and removal of difficulties 19. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, if the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may by order, not inconsistent with the provisions of these rules and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules or remove any difficulty for which no express provision exists in the rules.

SCHEDULE-I

(DEED OF AGREEMENT)

(To be executed by all Students admitted into DM or M.Ch. course)

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on this day of 20 between the State of Assam, Medical Education and Research Department to be represented by Sri/Dr./Prof.S/O, aged about years, presently holding the post of the Principal, Medical College, in the Medical Education and Research Department, hereinafter to be referred as the First Party and (Name of the student) S/O aged about years, resident of Vill/Town, PO. PS. Dist. State hereinafter referred as Second Party.

AND WHEREAS the Second Party has fully understood the "Medical Colleges of Assam (Regulation of Admission into 1st year Doctorate of Medicine (D.M)/Master of Chirurgiae (M.Ch) courses) Rules, 2024 and accordingly has been admitted in the DM/M.Ch. Course in the Medical College, and shall complete the three year course.

AND WHEREAS the Second Party shall bear only the admission fees, hostel fees, and other charges for the course and the First Party shall give the monthly stipend / Salary to the Second Party during the period of DM/M.Ch. Course.

AND WHEREAS the Government of Assam shall incur huge expenditure from State Exchequer for the purpose of imparting education to the Second Party in pursuing the DM/M.Ch. Course in a State Government Medical College in Assam.

AND WHEREAS in the interest of public service, the First Party has decided to give admission to the Second Party in the DM/M.Ch. Course at Medical College, in the State of Assam and shall bear the expenses of his/her education, other than the admission fees, hostel fees and other charges, in pursuing the said course.

NOW, THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSES THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. That, after completion of his/her DM/M.Ch. Course the Second Party shall serve the State Government Medical College for minimum period of 1(one) year upon offer of appointment /15 years of Regular Government Service.
2. That, the First Party shall have the authority to utilize the service of the student i.e. the Second Party in any Hospital/Medical Institutions within the State of Assam where there is necessity of a Doctor in the interest of public service.
3. That, in case of any breach of the terms and conditions as stated hereinabove, the Second Party shall be liable to pay an amount of Rs.30,00,000.00 (Rupees Thirty lakhs) only / Rs. 1.00 Crore (Rupees one crore) only as compensation to the First Party, i.e. the Government of Assam, Medical Education and Research Department. The amount is to be paid by way of Bank Draft in favour of Director of Medical Education Assam payable at Guwahati.
4. That, in case of failure to pay the compensation as mentioned above, the First Party shall be at liberty to file a Money Suit and/or take any other appropriate legal action against the Second Party in the competent court to recover the same at the risk and cost of the Second Party.
